FOOD FOR THOUGHT Good Fruit, Good Tree

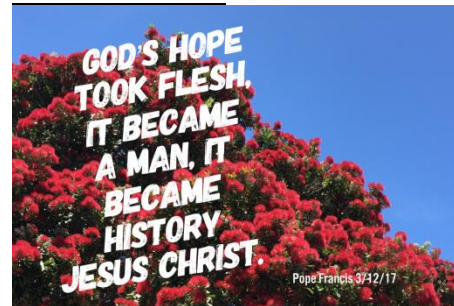
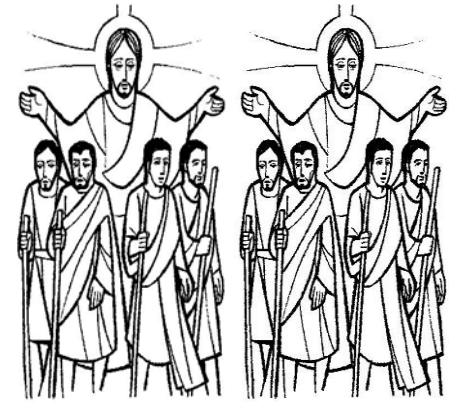
